

## Faculty Positions in Geography and Atmospheric Science

School of Geographic Sciences at East China Normal University, Shanghai, China, invites applications for multiple open-rank positions from post-doctoral fellowship to professorship in all aspects of Geography and Atmospheric Science. Department of Geography, the predecessor of the School of Geographic Sciences, was founded in 1951, as the first newly-established geography department since the beginning of P.R. China. In March 2014, the Faculty of Earth Sciences was established. It includes School of Geographic Sciences, School of Urban & Regional Science, School of Ecological and Environmental Science, and Institute of Estuarine and Coastal Research. School of Geographic Sciences has one of the first Ph.D. programs in geography approved in China, one of the first geographical postdoctoral posts in China, and one of the two earliest units owning key disciplinary in physical geography in China.

On October 16, 1951, East China Normal University (ECNU) was established out of the Great China University and Kwang Hua University's arts and science faculties. The intellectual wealth from Great China University, Kwang Hua and other universities and colleges laid a solid foundation for ECNU, while the transformation of departments in the early 1950s infused new effectiveness into ECNU. East China Normal University (ECNU) was sponsored by the national programs "Project 211" and "Project 985" in 2006. Through decades of teaching and research practice, the university's motto of "Seek Truth, Foster Originality, and Honor the Teaching Profession" and the university's ideology of "Creativity, Character and Community" have inspired generations of ECNU teachers and students to strive hard for the development of China's basic education and the prosperity of the country. Now, ECNU is steadily and enthusiastically working towards its goal of establishing itself as an internationally renowned high-level research university, and will therefore play a more prominent role in China's rise in the 21st century.
